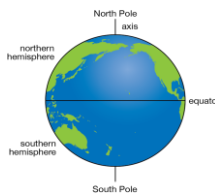
Features of the Continents

- **Asia:** the largest continent. The Taj Mahal is a human feature.
- **Africa:** a hot continent. Mount Kilimanjaro is a physical feature.
- **North America:** made up of states. Victoria Falls is a physical feature.
- **South America:** a tropical continent. Christ the Redeemer is a human feature.
- **Antarctica:** the coldest continent. Ice caps are physical features.
- **Europe:** we live here. The Sagrada Familia is a human feature.
- **Australia:** the smallest continent. The Great Barrier Reef is a physical feature. Canberra is the capital city of Australia.



Hot and Cold Countries

- The closer to the equator, the hotter the country is.
- The further from the equator, the colder it is.
- Some cold places are: Finland, the Arctic, Norway, Greenland.
- Some hot places are: Saudi Arabia, Australia, Mexico, Sahara desert.



Europe

- The United Kingdom is in Europe.
- Another country in Europe is France.
- Human features in France include: The Eiffel Tower.
- Physical features in France include: Lac d'Allos.
